

Fold Flat Pop Up

This has been one of my favorite fancy folds for some time. It is simple and so different. It is a perfect card to display.

I saw this card back in 2018 on MayMay Made It by Stacy Williams.

Measurements

First Color

For Base: 4 1/4" x 8 3/8"

For Base: 3" x 4 7/8"

Accent Color

Front Panel: 2 3/4" x 3 1/4"

Back Panel: 4 1/4" x 4"

White

White Front Panel: 2 1/2" x 3"

White Back Panel: 4" x 3 3/4"

DSP Option

1 1/4" x 4"

2 3/4" x 4"

Score the larger base at 3/8", 1 3/8", 2 7/8" and 3 7/8" on the longer side.
For the smaller base, score at 3/8" and 1 3/8".



On the larger base you can either stamp or add dsp. If you stamp, you will stamp one side that is scored and then the reverse side you will stamp the non scored part.

When you fold up the scored part into a box, all of the stamped images will show on the front. Make sure you pay attention to how you are stamping the box images so they are not flying upside down (in this case). You can also add DSP. I do both versions in the video.

Fold all score lines after stamping (if you choose this method of decorating). In the DSP version, add it before you adhere the smaller flap. Add glue to the small 3/8" flap and adhere it to the front panel creating a box at the bottom of the cardbase.



Take the smaller base and score and add glue to the 3/8" flap. Align the bottom of the smaller base to the bottom of the box while in the open position. Then lay it flat and adhere the smaller flap.



Adhere the white and the accent color together once you have decorated or stamped your panels. Below is an example of the DSP version.



Embellish to your hearts content and enjoy this adorable fancy fold. Don't forget to decorate the back.



I hope you give it a try. It is super easy and so fun to create.
